#### **EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS**

#### **Traditional**

- Students return to normal instruction at their home school
- Instruction is teacher-led
- All learning occurs in traditional classrooms with modifications that promote social distancing to the extent possible.

### **EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS**

#### Virtual

- Students participate in all online instruction away from school campuses
- Instruction is mostly self-paced
- Students who enroll the Calhoun Virtual Instruction Program must remain enrolled until the end of the semester

### **FACE MASKS**

- Face masks are required on buses and in hallways
- Students and staff are encouraged to wear face masks in classrooms
- Face masks will be provided for students, if needed



#### TRANSPORTATION

- Bus drivers, monitors, and students will wear face masks while riding the bus
- Bus drivers will provide a face mask to students who do not have their own
- Hand sanitizer will be provided on all buses



#### **SANITATION & SAFETY PROTOCOLS**

- Frequent visual and verbal hygiene reminders
- Handwashing for 20 seconds
- Hand sanitizer will be available in all classrooms
- Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned periodically throughout the day

## PARENTS/VISITORS

- All parents, volunteers, and visitors must be screened and wear a face mask before being admitted to campus.
- All parents and adults are encouraged to remain in their vehicles during morning and afternoon drop off or pick up
- Appointments are encouraged when possible

#### SCHOOL CLOSURES

- If/when a school closure occurs, students will continue their instruction through a hybrid distance learning format using Google Classroom.
- All IEP services will be provided to the extend possible
